

Report No. 1 367th Bomb. Group (H).Month of May, 1944, by Capt. Wiley W. Glass**SECRET**

DAY	OPERATIONS
1st	<p>Twenty one A/C led by Capt. McManon took off to bomb targets in the Calais area. Extreme difficulty was encountered forming up due to clouds and darkness. No bombs were dropped due to weather conditions over the target, and all returned to base.</p> <p><u>Rheims, France.</u> The Eager Beavers, led by Lt. Reeder, formed the low squadron (7 A/C) of the lead group of the 40th CGW. Bombing was excellent with hits on the marshalling yards. No E/A were seen and only moderate accurate flak was encountered north of the target. All of our A/C returned to base.</p> <p>Major Husband appointed Group Operations Officer. Lt. Col. Williams transferred to 367th and made Commanding Officer. Capt. Witt transferred to Headquarters from 367th Squadron.</p>
4th	<p><u>Berlin (Recall).</u> Eighteen A/C led by Capt. Peterson, 369th, took off to bomb targets in the "Big Town". Heavy clouds and persistent contrails hindered assembly and made formation flying impossible. The group was recalled when they were over Holland. No E/A were seen and only moderate and inaccurate A.A. fire was met going in at the Dutch coast. All bombs were returned.</p> <p>Major Chalfant appointed Commanding Officer of the 423rd.</p>
7th	<p><u>Berlin.</u> Twenty five A/C were put on today. Capt. Peterson, 369th, led the low group with 18 ships, and an additional 6 flew high squadron of the composite group. Bombing was by PFF through 10/10 cloud. No E/A were seen. Flak was moderate and inaccurate at the target. Two of our A/C returned early.</p>
8th	<p><u>Berlin.</u> Thirty A/C took off and bombed the target through 10/10 cloud on PFF technique. No E/A were encountered and a flak barrage over the target was low on this CGW. Our A/C flew low group led by Capt. Grending, 368th, also lead and low squadrons of the high group, led by Capt. Peterson of the 369th. Heavy persistent contrails made visibility difficult. Lt. Lambert of the 369th, and Lt. Jacobs of the 368th, moving out of their respective formations to avoid prop wash, collided and fell, hitting Lt. Schlect's (369th) ship, all going down. Only one chute was observed. In addition to these three A/C, Lts. Matichka and D.A. Smith of the 367th failed to return. Friendly escort was good throughout.</p>
9th	<p><u>Thionville A/D, France.</u> Major Salada with 18 of our A/C, led this group and CGW. Bombing results were excellent as shown by strike photographs. No E/A were seen. Meager accurate flak was encountered at the enemy coast upon return. Friendly fighters were in sight at all times.</p> <p>Capt. Kenealy assigned to Hq. from 423rd Squadron.</p>

DAY	OPERATIONS
11th	<u>Saarbrücken.</u> Today's target was the Railway Traffic Center. Weather was clear with a heavy ground haze at the target necessitating a second run by some formations. Twenty-four A/C were airborne and twenty-three attacked the target. No E/A were encountered and fighter support was good. Moderate accurate tracking flak at the target knocked out Lt. Mills, 369th, and he failed to return.
12th	<u>Merseburg, Germany.</u> Twenty-five A/C took off and twenty-three attacked the synthetic oil plants with good results. No E/A were encountered and escort was good. A.A. fire was meager and inaccurate. All of our A/C returned to base.
13th	<u>Stettin, Germany.</u> Lt. Col. Raper with twenty-two A/C of this Group led the 306th and twenty bombed the target on PFF. Pictures through a hole in the clouds show a good concentration in the city. About 100 E/A were seen but none attacked this CEF. Fighter support was good. Flak over Stettin was accurate and Lt. Hanson, 367th, was hit causing successive engines to go out enroute home. Sixty miles off the English coast Lt. Hanson called the Group leader that he was going to ditch. S.O.S. was sent out and position was reported to Air Sea Rescue. A plane was dispatched from our formation to circle and mark ditched A/C until arrival of A.S.R. All crew members were rescued after being in the water about one hour. Lt. Jarvis, navigator 423rd, was hit by flak over the target and died before reaching England.
19th	<u>Berlin.</u> Twenty A/C led by Capt. Lund, 368th, flew low group of the 40th CEF. Nineteen A/C bombed the target on PFF through scattered cloud formation. No enemy fighters were seen. A.A. fire was intense but low at the target. Fighter support was good. Flak fragments came up Sgt. Parks' (waist gunner on Lt. McBride's A/C) trousers leg hitting his escape kit and he escaped being wounded.
20th	<u>Orly A/D, France.</u> The 306th flew twelve A/C led by Maj. Flannagan, 369th, forming lead group heading the Wing, and twelve A/C led by Capt. Grending forming low group in the 40th "A" CEF. Strike photos show a good concentration on the hangar area which was our SPI. No E/A were encountered and support was satisfactory. Meager and low A.A. fire was seen at the target.

22nd	<p><u>Giel</u>. The 306th flew twelve A/C as low group (Capt McMahon leading) and six A/C as lead and high elements of composite group (Capt Grenning lead) of the 40th CBW. Bombing by PFF although clear channel through clouds appeared over target. A good concentration was noted southwest of Naval Arsenal and across harbor into Deutsche Werke. A.A. fire was moderate and accurate. Fighter support was excellent. E/A were seen but no attacks made on our formations. One of our A/C returned early.</p>
23rd	<p><u>Metz</u>. The 306th flew twelve A/C as low group (Lt. Raster, 367th, leading) and nine A/C in high composite group (Capt. Lund, 368th, leading) of 40th CBW. Bombing was on PFF with unobserved results. No E/A were seen and only four bursts of flak encountered on entire route. Lt. Troup, 423rd, was seen to leave formation early with engine trouble, he later crash landed on the English coast killing all the crew except Lt. Telfer, S/Sgt. Herritt and T/Sgt. Kerr who were seriously injured.</p>
24th	<p><u>Berlin</u>. The 306th flew eighteen A/C as lead group (Lt. Col. H.C. Williams leading in PFF ship) and six A/C as high squadron of high composite group in 40th CBW. Lt. Bennett of the 369th was hit by flak over enemy coast and dropped bombs through solid overcast at a point estimated to be Hamburg. Escort was good, no attacks were made on this Wing although a number of B-17's were seen to be knocked out of formations ahead by E/A. Bombing was by PFF. Lt. Earler, 368th, received flak burst in tail just after bombs away and went down in a flat spin and disappeared through the clouds at about 18000 feet. Two chutes were seen.</p>
25th	<p><u>Thionville M/Y</u>. The 306th flew twelve A/C as low and twelve A/C as high groups of the 40th "A" CBW. This mission was a near perfect as could be hoped for. No flak and no E/A were encountered. Strike photos show heavy and compact concentration completely covering briefed MPI. Continuous support was given to and from the target. All of our A/C returned safely to base.</p>
27th	<p><u>Mannheim M/Y</u>. The 306th flew seventeen A/C led by Major Husband forming lead group of 40th CBW. No E/A were seen and close continuous support was given. A.A. fire was seen only at the target. Bombing was visual and MPI was covered with smoke.</p>

Report No. 4 of 1944 by 306th Bomb Group (H)

DAY	OPERATION
27th cont	<u>FeCamp/Tactical Target.</u> The 306th flew ten A/C plus two PFF as lead and low squadrons of 40th CG. This tactical target was identified visually but bombed on PFF according to order. Strike photos show main concentration in water one and a half miles west of target. No E/A or A.A. fire observed. Good area support was furnished.
28th	<u>Rhuland, Synthetic Oil Plant.</u> The 306th flew sixteen A/C plus two PFF as lead and eighteen A/C as low groups of the 40th "B" CG. Capt. Lund led the wing and Capt. Cannon led the low group. Route I.P. was flown as briefed; as the formation was turning on the bomb run a malfunction occurred when the CG leader opened his bomb bay doors causing most of his bombs, including two smoke bombs to go away. Most of the lead and low groups dropped on him at this time. The run was continued and lead dropped remainder of his bombs squarely on the M.P.I. Accurate flak was encountered from Meissen damaging fifteen of our A/C. No E/A were seen. Fighter support was good excepting fifteen minute gap at the target. Two of our A/C returned early because of malfunction.
29th	<u>Cottbus A/D, Germany.</u> Nineteen A/C led by Capt. Grenning flew high group in the 40th CG and 16 A/C attacked this A/C assembly plant. Weather over the continent was CAVU. Flying straight toward Berlin via Hanover the formation turned S.W. beyond Magdeburg to I.P. and target, then skirting Berlin and out to the Baltic east of Stettin and return over Denmark. During a gap in fighter support three swift passes were made by E/A in the Meseritz-Driesen area but no losses were sustained by this Group. A.A. fire was met at Duzer Lake, Danish Coast, and Heligoland. Strike photos show aiming points well hit. Our score for the day was 2-2-2.
31st	<u>Liege A/D.</u> The 306th flew three groups of twelve A/C each to form the 40th "A" CG with Col. Robinson leading the 1st Division. In an effort to dodge high cumulus clouds the formation climbed to 20,000 feet and went north of course in Ghent area thence to target. Clouds prevented lead and low groups from bombing in spite of a thorough search for a last resort target. Bombs of these two groups were returned. No E/A were seen. Moderate accurate tracking AA fire was encountered damaging eighteen of our A/C. Sgt. Jenkins on special duty here with 8th Air Force Photographic Section was killed when hit by flak.

A new record for this Group was established this month, (twenty

operations). A new high was set in sorties flown and bombs dropped while the proportionate losses and abortions per sortie were very low. During this period Berlin was attacked four times. Objectives were about evenly divided this month between airfields and marshalling yards. Enemy fighter interceptors were conspicuous by their absence. This Group was attacked on one mission during the month and lost no planes as a result while destroying four and damaging two of the enemy.
