WE MARRIED 2/9/44 AND IT WAS A GOOD MARRIAGE, MY HUSBAND WAS A REALLY NICE PERSON, I LOST HIM, MARCH 8, 1998, AND FIND LIFE HARD WITHOUT HIM. BUT MY MEMORIES CARRY ME ON AND I LOOK FORWARD TO YOUR PUBLICATION - THEN AFTER I AM THROUGH I SEND IT TO MY GRANDSON WHO IS AN ANY FAN OF ANYTHING TO DO WITH WWII AND THE 8TH AIRFORCE.
