FOLLOWING IS SOME INFORMATION ON ONE OF THE FLYING OFFICERS YOU LISTED ON PAGE 10 OF THE LATEST ECHOES:

RAYMOND E. GATES WAS COPILOT OF CHARLES J. THELEN JR.'S CREW WHEN IT ARRIVED AT THE 306TH ON 21 MARCH 1943. THE NAVIGATOR WAS SIDNEY S. MILLER AND THE BOMBARDIER WAS GEORGE L. LEWIS. THE CREW WAS SHOT DOWN ON 5 ~~MAY~~ APRIL 1943 AND WERE TOGETHER IN STALAG LUFT III.

GEORGE LEWIS TOLD ME AT THE STALAG LUFT III REUNION IN SEATTLE LAST MAY THAT NO ONE OF THE CREW HAS HEARD FROM GATES SINCE 1945. HE SAID HE WAS GOING TO CONTACT SEVERAL POSTMASTERS IN THE AREA OF GATES HOME TOWN IN KANSAS FOR SOME UP TO DATE INFO ON RAY. (I WAS THEIR ROOMMATE IN STALAG LUFT III.)
