Dear Bill:

The 306th did not get an oak leaf cluster to its Distinguished Unit Citation. However, the 369th Squadron did receive a citation, as well as the group; for the period during which they flew 39 missions without a loss in 1943.

As to filling out your military record, I believe that is likely to be impossible now because of the fire in the St. Louis, MO, records organization in the early 1950s. Most WWII personnel records were destroyed, and there was no way; to replace them.

Thus, one's own record becomes even more important.
