Carl E. Frymoyer, 61, of 21 W. 33rd St., Reiffton, died Wednesday in the Lebanon Veterans' Hospital, where he had been a patient since Oct. 30.

He was born in Reading, a son of Helen A. (Kazmierczak) Frymoyer, of Pennwyn, and the late Harry Frymoyer.

Frymoyer had been employed by Giorgio Foods Inc., Temple, last working Aug. 12.

He was a member of St. Luke's Evangelical Congregational Church, Shillington, and the Reiffton Fire Company.

He was an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II.

Surviving in addition to his mother are his wife, Pauline (Schlessman) Frymoyer and a daughter, Wendy Frymoyer, at home.

Eight sons: Carl E. Jr., Randy, Kevin and Darren, all at home; Jeffrey and Bruce, both of Reading; Barry, Sinking Spring and George, West Lawn.

Six grandchildren, a step-grandchild and a brother, Warren, Portland, Ore.

Also three sisters: Betty J., wife of Clifford Stoyer, Park Manor; Pauline, wife of Harold Weaver, Exeter Township; and Alice F., wife of George Bennethum, Sinking Spring.

Theo. C. Auman Inc. is in charge of arrangements.

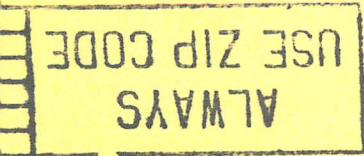
Dear 306'er:

We are trying to enhance the 306th mailing list and to locate a number of people--our Search List now is over 1000 names.

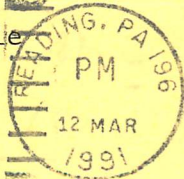
In you area we would like you to check the following persons, by looking in your phone book, by asking your local library for help, or your newspaper, or your county clerk, or the alumni office of your local college or university.

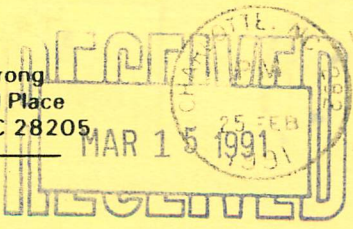

Dear Russ -  
 Unable to locate Carl E. Dymoyger with phone  
 or city directories, scoured a book named "Desert  
 Dymoyger" who referred me to one of Carl's sons. This  
 son, George, advised me that his father, Carl, died  
 on June 30, 1952 from a brain tumor. He has been con-  
 fined to a VA Hospital for a few years prior to his death,  
 probably the VA Hospital at Lebanon, Pa. He is buried  
 in Forest Hills Cemetery, 391 W. Reversink Road, Reading,  
 Pa. Carl was the father of 8 sons + 1 daughter.  
 According to his son, Carl, has been shot down and  
 spent the rest of the war in a prison camp. He was  
 unable to advise me of the identity of the pilot.  
 His son told me that Carl was reluctant to talk  
 about WWII, but did tell him that he has been  
 shot down on his 25th mission. The copy of the 306th  
 roster that I have for 1943 (Col. Robinson's command)  
 shows Carl E. Dymoyger as a ball turret gunner  
 on the 369th at the time of his death was  
 Carl's address at the time of his death was  
 21 West 33rd St, Leighton, Reading, Pa 19606  
 His wife's name was Pauline ~~Smith~~. His son  
 advised that Carl had shot down one enemy  
 plane. See copy of his obituary.
