Harold 'Nub' Hedin was born March 31, 1916 in Pillsbury, Minnesota, the son of the late Louis and Mary (Caine) Hedin. He grew up in Pillsbury and attended school in Swanville. After his schooling, Nub worked with his father as a carpenter building houses and barns. He entered the U.S. Army in 1941 and served in the Air Corp in the European Theatre until his discharge in 1945. Upon his discharge, Nub returned to

Pillsbury and purchased the Pillsbury Pavilion which he operated until 1966. He was united in marriage to Doris M. Hoare on June 25, 1947 in Sisseton, South Dakota. Nub also worked as a carpenter in Minneapolis for Orrin-Thompson building homes until retiring in 1974. He liked to hunt, fish and garden. Nub was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Swanville and the Swanville American Legion Post #313.
