I want to thank 306th Echoes for still sending me the newspaper. My husband was Anthony D. Johnson. He served in the 8th Air Force in England from June 1944 to December 1945. He was stationed at Thurleigh near Bedford, England.

The pictures I am enclosing were taken by his friend, Howard Lee. Howard carried the films back home and had them developed after the war had ended. He sent copies to my husband. In looking at the pictures I found some I thought might be of interest to other veterans.

As you can see, this is the one of the "Eager Beaver".

Anthony was an armorer and worked with the ground crew. He was very proud of his service and received the rank of Sergeant while overseas. He was with the 368th Group. He passed away July 31, 1998. Anthony would have enjoyed the reunions but his health did not allow us to attend.
