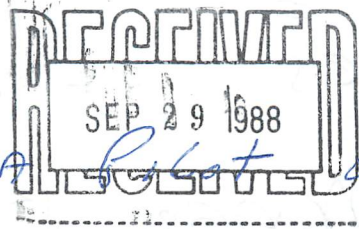


Dear Bill -
