MADISON — Thomas P. Moore Sr. died Tuesday at Morristown Memorial Hospital. He was 85. → 4/13/99

Born in Peachland, N.C., he moved to Madison in 1949.

Mr. Moore attended Berry College in Georgia for two years, moving to Jersey City and enrolling in New York University in 1937. He completed his bachelor's degree in accounting in 1947.

He was an accountant at Whitehead Metals in New York and a controller at Perkins-Goodwin in New York before retiring.



During World War II, he was an ordnance supply officer in the Army with the 306 Bombardment Group.

Mr. Moore was active in the Madison Senior Center and volunteered as a tax coordinator for senior citizens for 20 years. He was also a member of Grace Episcopal Church and served as an usher.

His wife, Florence C., and brother, John Crawford, died previously.
