ADDITIONAL NOTES:

ON MAY 2, 1945, A WEEK BEFORE THE END OF THE WAR IN EUROPE THERE WERE NO TARGETS LEFT TO BOMB BUT THEY DID WANT TO GET INFORMATION TO THE PEOPLE IN GERMANY. WE WERE DROPPING BARREL-LIKE CONTAINERS OF NEWS PAPERS ON PARACHUTES & UNLIKE THE BOMBING MISSIONS, FLYING WITH 1000 OTHER PLANES AT 25,000 FEET, WE FLEW THIS ALONG RIGHT AT GROUND LEVEL. WE DROPPED FIRST ON LUDWIGS HAVEN THEN WENT TO THE PRISON CAMP AT BUCHENWALD THAT HAD BEEN FREED THREE WEEKS EARLIER. THERE WAS THE GRAVE WITH A THOUSAND BODIES IN IT AND SURVIVORS ON THE GROUND WITH ARMS LIKE TOOTH PICKS WAIVING TO US. I FLEW AROUND THE CAMP FOR ABOUT A HALF HOUR AT GROUND LEVEL. I HAVE NEVER FELT THAT EMOTION AT ANY OTHER TIME IN MY LIFE - IF I COULD HAVE GOTTEN MY HANDS ON A GERMAN I WOULD HAVE KILLED HIM. IT WAS THE PERFECT WAY FOR ME TO END THE WAR. HOWEVER MANY PEOPLE I KILLED, OR HOW MUCH DAMAGE I DID ON THOSE 33 BOMBING MISSIONS I FLEW WAS MORE THAN JUSTIFIED BY WHAT I SAW THAT DAY.
