Our crew arrived around the first of June '44 and flew our first mission 19 Jun 44 over Calais, France. From there on through 30 Sept 44 we hit them all. Berlin, Leipsig, Munich and others. Our crew completed their 35 missions 30 Sept 44 thru 10 Oct 44.

The phote with the 30 bombs painted on nose is of the 'VERNA E'! The pilot, James Edeler, named the plane after and for his wife. It was a good ship and crew. To my knowledge we all returned to the states. We never aborted or had a reason.

We all had our lighter moments aside from the rigorous schedule of combat flights.

I remember when Queen Elizabeth came to the field, along with King George, Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeths sister Margaret, to christen a plane that someone had named in her honor. We were 1500 feet above, flying in formation, making one pass over the field when the dignitaries all came onto the field. I do believe that every pilot and crew member observed the show until we were out of sight of the field. As they would say "Good Show".

I have enjoyed the 306th paper.
