HERE'S CLIPPINGS RE KIETH JACKSON

I DID CALL SEVERAL 306 PEOPLE IN HOUSTON — ASKED THEM TO SHOW UP. I WENT TO FUNERAL AT FULSHEAR. DIDN'T RECOGNIZE ANYBODY IN CROWD AS 306 PEOPLE.

RECEIVED YOUR LIST OF "SPECIALTIES UNKNOWN". HAVEN'T FOUND AND NAMES I RECALL SO FAR. HAVE SENT COPY OF IT TO FRANK SOUIS (369TH SQDN. NAV. — MID 44 TO UNKNOWN) WHO WAS ON MY ORIGINAL KINSEY CROW AND WAS MY ROOMMATE IN 306 UNTIL I LEFT IN AUG 44. WILL ALSO CHECK OUT LIST WITH COUPLE OF OTHER 306 PEOPLE HERE IN TOWN.

IF THERE'S ANY OF THOSE 306 DECALS LEFT OVER — SEND AT LEAST 1 MORE TO ME PLEASE. WOULD LIKE TO PUT ONE IN SECOND CAR.

HERE'S COPIES SOME ORDERS I FOUND IN MY "HERO FILE" AND A COPY OF FIELD ORDER NO. 298. I DO NOT REMEMBER WHAT WAS PRIMARY TARGET BUT I HAVE RECOLLECTION THIS MISSION WAS CANCELLED EVEN BEFORE "START ENGINES".

SOME MARKED UP COPIES OF PICTURES ALSO INCLUDED. I HAVE A BLACK & WHITE ORIGINAL OF "D" DAY BRIEFING. ALSO HAVE A B&W ORIGINAL OF THAT ^{PART} BAKTER CROW WHICH I HAVE A NEW NEGATIVE AND A COUPLE OF 8X10 BLOW-UPS.

SORRY ABOUT LONG DELAY IN GETTING BACK TO YOU. HOLIDAYS AND FAMILY AND GRANDCHILDREN SLOWED ME DOWN.
