

If you do decide to send it to me, do not include any bomb strike photos, as I have a pretty good collection of these. I am interested in the orders which he may have retained from the time he joined the 306th until he left. Therefore, I am enclosing a copy of the order numbers and dates which I do have, and if you find any which are NOT on this list I would appreciate receiving copies of them. Historically, many of them are quite valuable in my research as the Air Corps did not save them, and they are thus not in government archives.
