6. ATTENTION UNIT VOTING OFFICER

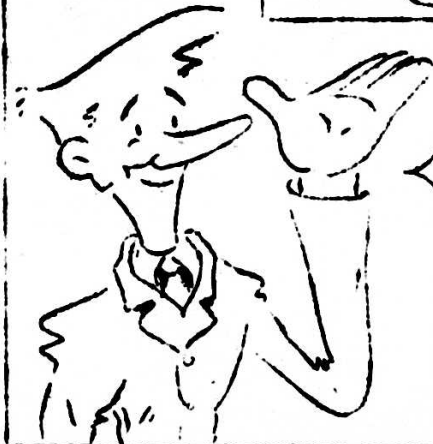
Each Unit Voting Officer will prepare a statement and forward to Major Miazza by 1200 hours, 16 August 1944, certifying as follows:
