4. **NOTICE** - The following Letter, Hq, 1st Bomb Division, dated 10 July, 1944 is quoted for the information of all concerned.

1. A large number of children have recently been evacuated from the Greater London Area to the geographical limits of the 1st Bombardment Division. This fact presents all United States drivers with added traffic hazards and an additional source of serious and fatal accidents.

2. All drivers will be informed of the above facts and Commanding Officers will insure that drivers comply with all safety measures and proceed with extreme caution while driving in the vicinity of cyclists, pedestrians, and passing through the cities and villages of this area.
