INFORMATION:

- By directive from Eighth Air Force, the Service Cap will not be worn by Enlisted Men either on or off the limits of this station.
- The Station Commander will hold a Personal Conference Hour, at 1100 hours, every Saturday, in the Conference Room at Station Headquarters.
- Officers ration card for purchase of clothing through Sales Stores are available at the Station Quartermaster. Officers who have not been in the Theater at least ninety days cannot draw ration card.
- Old type clothing certificates can no longer be used. New clothing ration cards can be obtained from the Station Quartermaster and will be used by all officers.
- In compliance with 1st Air Division teletype dated 14 Feb/45, Battle Jackets as described below are now authorized to be worn outside the jurisdiction of 1st Air Division: "7. A tailored jacket, of approved material and of the type heretofore issued experimentally in this theater, may be worn in lieu of the service coat. The buttons on such jackets will be of dark colored material. Buttons of gold or gold colored metal will not be worn. Insignia, decorations, badges, etc, will be worn as prescribed in regulations for the service coat."
