SUGGESTION: "Our supply has not as yet been able to get 9th AF patches, yet we look around us and we see those Fly by Night hawkers are selling these patches for 2/6. A #0.15 patch for #0.50. Why don't we stop this fraud, get the patches and issue them. The same thing can be said for service ribbons, etc."

ANSWER: No issue 9th Air Force patches are available in the G.I. Those sold on the street are British made. Following 9th Air Force directions, a requisition was submitted to 9th Air Force Service Command, (on the Continent), the 7th of June, for patches for both officers and enlisted men of this station. The basis of issue is to be three per enlisted man; and the price for officers is 0.12 each. A teletype has been submitted, asking what action has been taken by the issuing agency. As soon as an answer is received, SE will print the contents.

It is the responsibility of unit supplies to requisition service ribbons, etc. from the Supply Officer. Two weeks service may be expected, but not guaranteed.

Furthermore, SE strongly urges you not to spend your own money for these, since it is not known what patch the occupation Air Force will finally decide upon.
