SUGGESTION: "Suggest that Hq issue on the Daily Bulletin the dates of the campaign for which we have been awarded battle stars. Have we received official OK for stars for Ardennes and Central Europe campaigns?"

ANSWER: Since operation in this theater (9 October 1942 to 8 May 1945) the 306th Bomb Gp (H) has earned the following awards and battle participation credits:

- a. Battle Star for Air Offensive Europe (4 July/42 to 5 June/44)
- b. Battle Star for Normandy Campaign (6 June/44 to 24 July/44)

c. Battle Star for Northern France Campaign (25 July/44 to 11 Dec/44)

2. In addition the War Department has redesignated the Campaign "Germany" (formerly with listing dates 15 Sep/44 to 21 Mar/45) to Campaign "Rhineland" (same dates). Two new campaigns have been established: "Ardennes" (16 Dec/44 to 25 Jan/45), and "Central Europe" (22 Mar/45 to 11 May/45). The 300th De. Ab Gp (H) was accorded credit for old Campaign "Germany" and accordingly has been recommended for credit for new campaigns "Rhineland", "Ardennes", and "Central Europe". The points for the old "Campaign Germany" are not taken away during the writing period for the official news. However, points for the other two new campaigns cannot be counted until the Group has been accorded official credit.
