Although we were denied the Bronze Service Star and Citation for the same type of work done in the past, this "commendation" received by the Bomb Group is the straw that broke the camel's back.

We have been reading the history of the 306th Bomb Group and not once did they mention the Sub-Depot of the Eng'r. Sqdn.

Being here nearly as long as the Bomb Group and doing all the major repairs and major battle damage repair, we think that the least they could do, would be to mention our Sqdn once in awhile.

It seems that when there is work to be done, that we are considered part of the Bomb Group, but when it comes to receiving credit, we are a forgotten Sqdn.

ANSWER: Colonel UPHAM advised SB that he has not commanded the Bomb Group personnel for any work done by the Engineering Squadron.

There is no record in Station Headquarters of the "commendation" you refer to in connection with the present modification of camouflage. If such a commendation exists, SB would like a copy.

No person on this Station is responsible for the "battle star" situation. As explained in answers to previous questions, the Station Commander has done all he can on this matter. Your attention is invited to "Yan" for 20 June 1949 for further information on this subject.
