21st May, 1945.

Dear Sir:

One of the most pleasing incidents in our Victory celebrations was the sight of a small squad of your boys marching smartly down the High St and saluting with military precision, the flags that hung from the houses.

There were not many Stars & Stripes amongst them, simply because not many of us had the American flag, but I can assure you we do honour your flag and your gallant troops.

You have often kept us awake at nights with your "hoorings", when we were very tired and anxious, but we realised that it meant that your boys were at work out there on the cold aerodrome, often in frosted snow, preparing the planes for your crews to take off on another dangerous mission, and to strike a blow at the enemy.

We realize that without your exertions we could never have hoped to subdue Germany and all her evil doings, and we would like to say "Thank-You" to you and all under your command.

We hope you will all soon be able to enjoy the fruits of your labours at home among your own families and friends.
