"EVERY EM 42 YEARS OF AGE OR OVER WITH HONORABLE SERV WHO VOLUNTARILY APPLIES IN WRITING TO HIS IMMEDIATE CO FOR DISCH WILL BE SENT TO A SEPARATION CENTER AS PROVIDED IN CURRENT INSTRUCTION FOR DISCH UNDER PROVISIONS OF AR 615-365 (CONVENIENCE OF GOVT) AND SECT 1 WD CIR 125 DTD 25 APR 45. SUCH YERS OVERSEAS WILL BE RETURNED IN EXCESS OF ROTATION QUOTAS. MIL RESERVES OR LIMITATIONS WILL NOT BE A BAR TO DISCH: HOWEVER THIS AUTH WILL NOT BE USED IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION NOR WHEN DISCH UNDER OTHER AR IS APPROPRIATE NOR WHEN INDIV CONCERNED IS UNDER MEDICAL OR SURGICAL TREATMENT."
