### Addresses Now on Computer

This issue of **Echoes** has been delayed because we have been "tooling up" to get all of our addresses on a computer. That has now been completed--and we hope a high percentage are correct.

But we would encourage you to correct this mailing label, if it is in error by filling out the coupon in this issue. We have considerable information in the computer on each of the more than 1,050 names we now have but yours may not be filled out. Please help us with this data.

Now that we have the names on the computer, and can get mailing labels out, the information should stay constant. We have lost names from our list, and been unable to keep corrections constant because there has been so much handwork involved. Mailing labels have been typed for each issue and this has been time consuming and led to many inaccuracies. The biennial retyping of the "known" list, working from half a dozen sources has also induced many errors.

We hope this is now licked, and urge you to bear with us in this final round of corrections. The computer will also permit us to keep up to date on addresses more easily than has been possible in the past. We are adding names weekly, and hope that you will take the time to help us.

Our search list has shrunk somewhat, but we can stand to have it enlarged. Look through newspaper clippings, address books, Christmas card lists. All of these are sources for more names.

You can help us by looking in your own area. We will be happy to provide you with a search list for your city, state, area, or whatever. Contact Bill Collins or Russ Strong, and they will help you with the search. We have combed through much of the Eastern U. S., but still need a lot of work west of the Mississippi, with special emphasis on California and Texas.

### Thurleigh Today

Many of you who reminisce about those "Good Old Days" at Thurleigh, of huddling up to a pot-bellied stove roasting ones face whilst icy droughts blow across your back; of freezing fog and squelching mud, of crazy cycle rides down to the "Jackal" or the "Falcon" and of the heartfelt relief as the wheels screeched safely onto the runway at the end of another mission, must often wonder what has become of the old place, or even whether it still exists.

Yes, the base is still there although it is so changed that very little of Station III can be recognized. Many World War Two airfields, both RAF and American, were dismantled, the runways dug up and used for hardcore and the land returned to farming, but not so in the case of Thurleigh.

Long before the last GI moved out of the base at the end of 1945, the field had been earmarked to be developed into the most advanced aviation research centre in Europe. Aircraft bigger and heavier than anything before were visualised and a field had to be built to enable experimental flying to be carried out. To this end, a gigantic runway twice the width of anything seen in WW2 was to be constructed, extending right back across country to the nearby airfield of Little Staughton, a full five miles in length. This runway was never completed to its full length due to changes in ideas concerning aircraft development, but even in its shortened form it has cut right through what was the flightlines, and the HQ area; the original Control Tower, if it has been allowed to remain, would have stood squarely in the middle of the runway halfway along its length!

Most of the original buildings have long since been dismantled and many new hangers and office blocks erected on the North and West edges of the field.

About all of the original field recognisable to a returning veteran would be the Red Cross Aero Club, a part of the Enlisted Men's Mess, the "Eager Beaver" Squadron Office, the old main runway and the North-South runway which are still in use, and the old 40th Combat Wing HQ which is now reconstructed as an RAF Officers Mess. Two of the old hangers are still here but they have been moved from their original positions and will only confuse people trying to get their bearings from them.

A handful of derelict huts still standing on the 423rd living site just about completes the picture. The Thurleigh-Keysoe road now detours a good mile and a half round the end of the new big runway thus confusing those people who in the past have gone back to Thurleigh and started walking down the road from the Chapel looking for the base!

Remember that "First" might well have been the motto of the 306th, recalling the early times when many of the things first done by the Group became S.O.P., together with the claim of "First Over Germany", it will be pleasing to you to learn that under the name of the "Royal Aircraft Establishment" the field carries on with this tradition! It was here that

**12 Minutes of Combat  
December 20, 1942**

**Casey's Crew  
Downs Seven**

A press handout from the European Theater, dated November 27, 1942, reported:

"Details of an hour's battle over the Bay of Biscay in which a single flight of United States Army Flying Fortresses destroyed nine German fighter planes was made public today by headquarters, Eighth Air Force. One Fort alone accounted for seven of the enemy aircraft."

One Fort alone accounted for seven—that was Casey. First Lieutenant William J. Casey is five feet seven and a half inches of pilot, topped off with a broad smile when he is happy. And he is happy most of the time.

He was happy that bleak November day as he taxied his giant plane down the runway and took off for the target of the submarine nest at Saint-Nazaire. The U-boat bases at Brest, Lorient and Saint-Nazaire are guarded by swarms of Focke-Wulfs with their noses painted yellow to warn the bombers that they are flown by the toughest fighting men in the Luftwaffe, the "Abbeville Kids"—so named by First Wing because they are based at Abbeville.

The bombers accomplished their work over the target before the Kids arrived that day, but the yellow-nosed fighters snapped hungrily at the Fortresses as they made off over the Bay of Biscay. The fight lasted for an hour, with the daring Focke-Wulfs boring in as close as 50 yards to deliver their 20-mm. shells.

For Casey and his crew the action lasted only 12 minutes, but in that flickering space his gunners knocked down seven Jerries.

The battle began with a single Focke-Wulf steaming in from dead ahead, sweeping below the Fortress beneath the tail-gunner's post and high-tailing it for a new position from which to launch a fresh attack. Sergeant Perley D. Small, Casey's "tail-end Charley," caught him full in his ring sights. The Focke-Wulf came apart, the pilot opening his chute as he fell.

Then action flared like a freshly fed gas fire. As the first Focke-Wulf fell apart, another Nazi drove in toward the tail, from four o'clock. The starboard-waist gunner, Staff Sergeant Reginald G. Harris nailed him with a single vicious burst. The Focke-Wulf dived into the sea.

Six more of Goering's best tried a simultaneous swoop. The first, coming from below at three o'clock, took the tracers of the ball-turret gunner, Sergeant Joe Bowles and the fighter exploded, falling in pieces through the sunlight to the sea. At the same moment, Staff Sergeant Wilson Elliott brought down the second plane in flames. Only a split second later, Gunner Harris raised his bag to two by forcing the pilot of another Focke-Wulf to bail out. From the ball turret, busy Joe Bowles got in another burst at an attacker coming from below and that plane disintegrated. The seventh victim fell to the guns of Staff Sergeant Allan F. Meaux, the port-waist gunner, who saw the plane disappear into the sea in a cloud of spray and steam. The lone survivor of the Nazi formation left without attacking.

# 306th Combat Crew Captain's Handbook

Dr. Doug Schrack, onetime 423rd pilot, found in his files the accompanying "Combat Crew Captain's Handbook", part of which is used below. It's one of those things that kind of takes you back, and the editor thought you might enjoy a look at it.

General: It is doubtful that if ever in the history of civilization individuals of our age and background have carried responsibilities so heavy as that of a combat crew Captain. You are the representative of one of the proudest Governments in the world and as such you are its most important means of carrying this war to the heart of the enemy and preventing the devastation of our own homeland. You are charged directly with the lives of nine (9) individuals besides your own. (It takes some twenty (20) years to grow a man - an airplane can be built in a few months.) You are charged with the operation of almost one-half million dollars worth of invaluable Government equipment. Your airplane is one of the most highly technical and infinitely complicated instruments of warfare ever conceived by man. Whether it operates effectively or whether you needlessly sacrifice the lives of your crew and the efforts of our workmen on the home front depends entirely upon your technical ability, your flying skill, your good judgment, and your attention to minute details.

(b) Your Crew: You must be a mother, brother and father confessor to your crew. It is up to you to see that each member of your crew is properly fed, clothed, trained, given the proper amount of relaxation and kept thoroughly fit for combat. It is also up to you to see that each individual combat crew member keeps his combat equipment in the very best condition possible, his guns clean, and reports on time to the proper place.

(1) Your Co-Pilot: Your Co-Pilot is a potential combat crew captain and flight commander. If he isn't we don't want him. Train him as such. Make him understudy you in everything you do. Put as much responsibility on him as he can carry efficiently. His graduation to the pilot's seat will come very rapidly if he has the proper stuff.

(2) Your Navigator is more important in this theater of war than he was during the training program. He is your brains and he also mans one of the most important guns in the airplane. See that he can navigate by pilotage, dead reckoning, radio aids and by celestial objects both by day and by night and in all conditions of visibility. Make him feel that his job is highly important. Good navigators are hard to find. If you have a good one he will get a promotion shortly.

(3) Your Bombardier must learn a new technique of AFCE bombing. He must man a very important gun position. At times he must navigate. He must learn to accurately determine the wind direction and velocity. His job is highly

technical and the instruments he uses are among the most complicated in existence. It is a good idea to make him your airplane Armament Officer.

(4) Your top turret gunner is no longer someone who transfers gas for you and calls off the air speed when you land. He is probably the single most important individual in the defense of your airplane. If your airplane is damaged he will help more than any other individual to get you home. He is also the engineer on the ground who keeps you continually informed of the status of all equipment in your airplane.

(5) Your Radio Operator has a highly important job to perform. He can bring you home when other methods of navigation fail. He can call for help when you need it. He is in a central position in the airplane and can move about more readily than any other combat crew member when it becomes necessary to take care of wounded or to make emergency repairs on equipment. Some day the effective fire from his gun will keep the enemy from dropping a bomb in your radio hatch. He is also responsible for the maintenance and operation of every item of radio equipment in your airplane.

(6) Your Ball Turret Gunner occupies a cold, uncomfortable and dangerous position. Yet, you will find that he generally fires more ammunition in combat than any other gun position. He must be a good gunner and he must have a fighting heart. It is also well to charge him with the responsibility of seeing that all emergency equipment is properly installed and in good operation. This means oxygen properly serviced, walk around and bail out bottles in the proper place, life rafts, emergency radio in position and properly serviced, first aid kits, fire extinguishers and spare oxygen masks all in place when they are needed.

(7) Your Waist Gunners: One of them will be your assistant engineer and the other will probably be your assistant radio operator. See that they perform these functions in addition to manning their guns.

(8) Your Tail Gunner is, in addition to covering an important area in your defense, the eyes in the back of your head. He tells you how the formation behind you is disposed. He tells you when to take evasive action when flak bursts start closing in. He tells you when people are in trouble and he generally sees more than any other combat crew member. Tell him all you know about flying, about formations, about tactics so that in addition to being a gunner he will be a tactical advisor. It is a good idea to make him your airplane chief.

(b) We know that all of your crew members were not properly trained to do all the things that we have found it necessary for them to do. We know your gunners aren't artists, that your navigators and bombardiers need more training. We know that your radio operators are probably bewildered at the



complexity of the communications procedure in this theatre. We have all sorts of training devices and we run classes continually. It is up to you to tell your operations officer of the type of training each individual needs and then to see that he goes to the classes and benefits by them when there is a schedule. That's a little enough to ask when it will probably save your life.

(c) Your airplane will probably need a lot of going over before it is ready for combat. There are a lot of tricks about the operation of equipment in the extreme cold of high altitude which your crew chief and your flight commander will tell you. This will get your superchargers to functioning properly, your heater, guns and turrets to working when you need them, your bomb doors to open and close, and to keep your crew members from coming down with frozen hands and toes. Listen to them because they know what they are talking about. But in addition to having all of your equipment functioning properly at high altitude there are a great many other things that you must do. Unless you take an interest in the cleanliness and state of maintenance of your airplane your ground crew will become lax and one day you will have equipment failure in a most embarrassing situation. Your AFCE must be working properly, your radio compass must be calibrated. Your compasses must be swung and properly installed. Your airspeed indicators must be

calibrated and your free air thermometers must be calibrated. All of these things require work and worry and nobody's going to do it for you. But if you don't do it, your bombs are going to miss the target and as a result we will all find ourselves going back time and again to targets which should have been obliterated the first time across.

(d) In addition to your other responsibilities you have a great responsibility to your fellow crew members, to the people who fly in the formation with you. Our tactics are sound, they were evolved by the cruel trial and error method. Our mistakes were paid for with the lives of many of our best friends, but we have evolved a system of attacking our targets with very little loss. The tactical plan is based on having a certain number of planes in a certain position in a big formation. It is the system of all around defense and no enemy airplane can approach our formation from any direction without having at least 35 .50 calibre machine guns staring him right in the face and within effective range. This means that when you take off to fill a position in a formation it is assumed that you are going to defend your assigned sector all the way to and from the target. If, for any reason, you do not maintain your position in the formation you are exposing the rest of the formation to an avenue of easy attack and you are reducing the fire power of the formation by approximately 10 percent. We don't want you to take a bad airplane into enemy territory, but we do want you to keep your airplane in good shape and not to abort unless you have serious trouble.

(5) Conclusion: All this sounds like a big order and it is a big order, but if you will look around and investigate the functioning of the old combat crew members who have survived the experimental stage when losses were naturally heavy you will see that the broad principles laid down in this pamphlet are those which were evolved over a period of time as the only ones which are effective in this theater. Your flight commander, your operations officer and the air executive are all available to help you with any problem you might have. The door to the Group Commander's Office is always open. We will see that the facilities are made available to you in order that you may accomplish everything that is necessary. In return we expect you to put in a working day of ten (10) or twelve (12) hours when you work. You will be given enough time off to get ample relaxation. We have a good many parties and a lot of fun but at reveille the next morning everybody gets up, goes to work and works hard until the work is done. Good luck to you and we are expecting a lot of help from you.
