SUBJECT: Intelligence Narrative
Mission: Montbartier and St. Loubes

TO : Commanding Officer, 306th Bombardment Group (H)

1. Narrative

The 306th Group flew 36 A/C as the 40th "B" CBW and six A/C 305th High composite group of 40th "C" CBW, plus one spare with 92nd Group in 40th "A" CBW. The 40th "B" formation flew briefed course except I.P. selected was 12 minutes from target instead of 7 as briefed. Selsey Bill 1122 hours; enemy coast in 4918N x 0005W; I.P. 4423N x 0155E, 1338 hours; target 1349½; enemy coast out 4917N x 0008W, 1559 hours; Selsey Bill 1631 hours; base 1732. 40th "C" CBW flew approximately briefed course, target 1347½, base 1637 hours.

2. Fighter Opposition and Fighter Support

No E/A opposition.

P51's met the formation inside the French coast and gave continuous and close support to target and all the way out.

3. A.A. Gun Fire

Meager inaccurate tracking upon crossing French coast. A few very accurate bursts from Lisieux, in the words of one pilot from low group (40th "B") "got about every ship in our group". Actually 5 damaged in low group, 3 severe.

4. Bombing

40th "B" - bombing was excellent but the crews came back with a feeling of having "drawn blank". In spite of covering the MPI with 1000 lb. bombs, pictures show no fires such as might be expected from a well-hit oil target.

40th "C" - pictures show target well hit with big column of smoke, which crews report could be seen for miles after leaving target.

5. Weather

40th "B" - 2 to 4/10 cumulus, tops 14000 feet, with tops 20000 to northeast. Clear at target.

40th "C" - broken cumulus 4 to 5/10, tops 15000 feet, clear at target.

6. Observations

About 30 oil storage tanks observed at 4718N x 0142 or 0128E, south of an airdrome.

7. A/C Returning Early

40th "B" - 017-Z, pilot Burnett, due to oil leak, feathered #2 engine, and turned back at Mount Farm Buncher, 1029 hours, brought back 5 x 1000 HE.

- one spare, 365-Z, pilot Lingwall, turned back as briefed, 1123 hours, 5040N x 0040W, brought back 5 x 1000 HE.
