0640 Cleared Cycle RELAY Through 1st Div.

T.O. 0745 CC OUT FRINTON ON SEA - 0825

0745 R/W changed to 18 ~~South to N~~ and inspected

0803 Cycle Relay airborne

0815 Asphacting on R/W 06

- 0815 Green to dir.
- 0905 M.P.6 placed on North and South ends of R/W 18
- 0920 Ordnance informs us that they will be burning incendiary bombs all day today.
Dir. notified
- 0940 Off duty Lt. Caillie; Lt. Klein on duty
- 10:40 Col McDonald going to Farnborough. Weather is bad but F.C.O. said he would accept him. Vis 1000 yds., drizzle, low cloud base. (P-47)
- 11:30 Inspected airfield. Asphalt laying in progress. They will smooth off edge of strips on R/W 30 this afternoon. Perimeter & rest of R/W's serviceable except for usual places.
- 1211 Dir. called gave us E.T.A. on Cycle relay with request we tell Sup. Ops.
- 1212 Informed Sup. of above. Sup. informs us truck is to report to us at 1240 for crew of 2 and they will eat at "B" mess.
- 1242 There may be some sqd. formations this afternoon. Weather going to be bad over camera bombing targeted by 1700 hrs. Sup. Ops. notified. Contact Sup. later as to final result.
- 13:15 Formation flying scrubbed per Sup. Operations.
- 16:00 Red to division & ops.
- 1755 On duty Lt. Fibley
- 1815 Laid 23 obstruction lights, two hurricane lights on each end of R/W 24 which I will be in use during the night. Suggest that lights other than hurricane lamps be used at the ends of the R/W. Hurricane lamps are too easily blown over by the wind.
- 1845 Not advise a wind SSW 35-40 MPH. 5-3, 40th & alert crew chief (for P-51) of the wind

1900 Blue path on 24 inspected and is serviceable. Contact lights are all O.K.

All R/W's and perimeter except from bomb dump to N. end of N-S R/W are serviceable.

1935. Beacon crew checked in, all is in good working order

1940 Crash crew & ACP dismissed

2015 Stood down for tomorrow Oct. 12, 1944

2230 We are alerted

2330 We are stood down - Why don't they make up their minds
