plane crashed & burned. Pilot killed. Wing
landed about a field away. R.A.F. personnel were
present at scene. Ship number unknown. Crash
occured at 14:50, fire was put out by Finmere
RAF personnel under Wing Comander Newbury.
They removed the pilot's body. Request guard &
removal of loaded guns. Lt. Johnson at division
was notified.
