SUNDAY, 22ND AUGUST, 1943

- 0001 All quiet.
- 0740 Aerodrome GREEN. Ops advised.
- 0900 Returned from 0845 a/c non-operational briefing, having given taxi instructions to pilots of 24 AC for takeoff NE-SW.
- 1230 Off watch, Lt. Conrad. On watch, Lt. Peterman.
- 1430 Caution inspection of General Drome Area made.
- 1515 Waterbeach requests possibility of using drome tonight for night flying exercise. Informed them we would check with weather and The Squadron operations to ascertain whether they will do any night flying.
- 1652 Wing +/c requests our Pundit from dusk until Dawn (R.G.)
- 1840 Issued 6 a/c "W0" to Pundit crew.
- 2000 Waterbeach inform us they will not be using us tonight.
- 2005 Group operations advise us of briefing scheduled for 0430 hrs for precise mission.
- 2056 Pundit crew called and say everything in order.
- 2100 Instructed flapack laid NE/SW.
- 2339 Pundit crew inform us that an a/c was circling Pundit. a/c was properly identified - and "T" was illuminated paint to field. Alarm lit up as a/c was approaching & away "Sugar" heard calling Earthquake, and received an answer. All lightning off as this a/c was presumed to be a/c which circled our Pundit.
