- 0915 Col. Upham request that we have a full
list of passengers going on the scheduled liner
ships. This will assist my list from May.
Maya and attack it to the clearance form.
No clearance will be issued without it.
- Col. Upham has been notified of the
Gen. coming on the ship from H-3 today.
- 0930 Made audience inspection - main gun and
permitted clear of obs. & serviceable.
- 1215 Off H. Blane On H. Blane
Runway changed to 30
- 1315 Then General arrives, notify Col Upham immediately
and have a/c taxi to base.
