

MONDAY 27 DECEMBER 1943

- 0735 GREEN TO OPS. MET. CONSULTED., Also 1st Division
- 1000 Made routine inspection of General Home area.
- 1005 Twinwood reports sighting of two parachutes N/W of them. Dispatched their ambulance for them. Above information passed on to 1st Div. 7/c. (Roger)
- 1100 Wind West 10 mph.
- 1230 1st Div. informs us that 221 - "G" damaged by 24 in med. air. Crew instructed to bail out. Pilot of 221 - Toombs at Northam St. Faith. Called 7/c H/sh Faith to ascertain whether they are fit (weaker) to take in a B-17 within the week & half. Said "it to take him"
- 1230 On duty - Lt. Heck.
- 1407 Twinwood reports unable to find a parachutists
- 1315 Attended briefing for practice mission - 1400 - 1600
- 1700 Gams issued NR to beacon crew
- 1730 Flare path laid NE - SW - #24
- 1738 Beacon reports in operation
- 1810 On Duty - St. Bermer
- 1921 all our at dawn - flying ended for tonight. Fresh crew and ambulance released.
- 2230 Ops advises that proposed mission for tomorrow scrubbed

Tuesday - 28 December 1943

- 0800 On duty - Lt. Heck
- 0715 Yellow passed to ops, 1st Division
