Lubojacky Family Letters

Dear Family

Most of the following letters were written by Alfred "Buddy" S. Lubojaeky between April 1942 and February 1945. They provide an unbelievable glimpse into family life during World War II. Some of them contain only references to anecdotes about kittens and cows but you will also meet many different family members and friends of the family. You will also gain a better understanding of how the war affected everyone and the great lengths that family members went through to keep in touch at a time when telephone, email, and text messaging weren't a viable option.

To help you maintain a point of reference, keep the following in mind. Buddy turned 18 years old in February 1942, just before these letters begin. Buddy was the son of Joseph Louis Lubojacky and Louise Antonio Franck-Lubojacky. He had two older sisters, Olga who married Ephram "EJ" or "Effie" Kaminsky and Sylvia who married Robert "Bob" Galler. He also had an older brother, Roman Edward "RE" Lubojacky who married for his first wife, Desilu. He had three younger sisters, Ellen "Bab", Alice, and Anna Felice "Baby Doll" and a younger brother, Walter. Baby Doll was born April 12, 1942 and would have been only a few years old during this time period. Walter was born June 5, 1939 and would have been less than 6 years old during this time period.

For a time, Buddy lived with Olga and EJ Kaminsky, EJ's brother, Daniel and Anita (who was probably Daniel's wife). Olga and EJ had a son, Everett "Sonny".

The letters make reference to various other family and friends. Uncle Felix was Felix Franck. Aunt Vinska was the wife of Arnold Franck. Justin, Marvin, and George Lubojacky are the sons of Charlie Lubojacky, and would have been Buddy's cousins. Edward, and Ethel are believed

to have been eousins. Brother Lawrence was probably an officer in the SPJST fraternal lodge and sold life insurance for the lodge.

The original letters, as of July 2008, are in the possession of Anna Felice Lubojacky-Mikeska. The following digital images of those letters have been cleaned and restored to the extent possible. If an envelope contained writing on the reverse, that image is included also.
